FPMC 6-4-30 Before a commercial operator shall be permitted to provide tours, excursions or instruction at the Town's fishing facility, he or she shall first provide to the Town Clerk a copy of the current public liability insurance policy with one (1) or more insurance carriers licensed to do business in the State who are acceptable to the Town, insuring claims and demands made by any person or persons for injuries received in connection with, or arising out of, the commercial operator's use of the Town's fishing facility. Such policy or policies shall contain limits of liability of not less than the monetary limitations for judgments against municipalities provided from time to time by the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, Section 24-10-101, et seq., C.R.S., or any successor statute. Such policy shall name the Town and the commercial operator as named insureds under such policy and shall be approved by the Town before the commercial operator shall be entitled to use the Town's fishing facility. The commercial operator shall maintain such insurance in full force and effect at all times while using the Town's fishing facility. The subject policy shall require at least ten (10) days' advance notice to the Town prior to cancellation of such policy.

Additional Information: * Proof of Colorado Outfitter's license renewal must be provided for April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023 to keep the commercial fishing permit in good standing past March 31st. Proof of liability insurance must be provided for January 1, through December 31, 2022 to keep commercial fishing permit in good standing.

APPLICANT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I hereby acknowledge and agree to all the rules and regulations of the Fairplay Municipal Code regarding Commercial Fishing and use of the Fairplay Beach and Reservoir. I specifically acknowledge and agree to the restrictions that all fishing shall be done from the shore, or constructed dock or while wading. The use of boats and/or flotation devices is prohibited.

Violators will be subject to fine and/or imprisonment. Anyone removed from the Fairplay Beach and Reservoir will forfeit any and all fees paid, and permit shall be revoked.
